



## DUTY OF CARE

Creating a safe and welcoming experience for all individuals who are onsite at events, including guests, event staff, and vendors, is The Resolution Project's top priority. We look forward to coming together with our community safely after more than a year of virtual gatherings.

We are monitoring the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and will be updating and evolving our Duty of Care in accordance with the [CDC](#), [W.H.O](#), and [New York State](#) recommendations. Because COVID-19 is extremely contagious, we have implemented the below preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19. However, we cannot guarantee that guests, volunteers, partners, or others in attendance will not become infected with COVID-19.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To gain entry to the event, guests must present both of the following:

- Proof of full COVID-19 vaccination (as least two weeks since the final dose) via one of the following methods:
  - Valid [Excelsior Pass](#) (or other State equivalent) or the NYC COVID Safe app ([Android](#) - [iOS](#)) indicating full vaccination;
  - CDC vaccination card with a valid photo ID, indicating that it has been at least two weeks since the final dose was administered.
- A verified credential (e.g. email, print-out, portal) of a recent negative test for COVID-19 via one of the following methods:
  - A negative PCR test result from within three days of the event.
  - A negative Rapid test result from a lab (not an at-home kit) from within 24 hours.

All guests will also have their temperature checked before entering the event.

### MASKS

Per current CDC Guidelines, fully vaccinated individuals will not be required to wear a face covering at this event.

Masks will be available onsite for those who wish to remain masked for added protection.

### HAND SANITIZER

Hand sanitizing stations will be present throughout the event space for use by all individuals.

### SOCIAL DISTANCING and VENUE SETUP

Signage will be used to encourage social distancing throughout the venue, as well as to inform guests of other safety reminders.

Where possible, windows and doors will be open to allow for better airflow.

### **VENUE GUIDELINES**

Our event venue, the Prince George Ballroom, released their [COVID-19 Safety Plan](#), which provides in-depth detail on how they will ensure a safe and healthy environment onsite for all participants, including vendors, attendees, and other event staff.

### **PERSONAL ACCOUNTABILITY COMMITMENT**

We can't return safely to in-person gatherings without the personal commitment of each of our guests, and are asking for your help in keeping all attendees healthy.

By attending a Resolution Project event, you agree to abide by and engage in conduct that is beneficial to the health and safety of yourself and others while attending the event. This includes, but is not limited to, onsite temperature checks, engaging in appropriate physical distancing, and not attending the event if you are ill or have been recently exposed to COVID-19.

**ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK.** By attending a Resolution Project (TRP) event, I acknowledge and understand the following:

1. Participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to COVID-19. While particular precautions and personal choices may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist;
2. I knowingly and freely assume all such risks related to illness and infectious diseases, such as COVID-19, even if arising from the negligence or fault of TRP and their associates; and
3. I hereby knowingly assume the risk of injury, harm and loss associated with the event, including any injury, harm and loss caused by the negligence, fault or conduct of any kind on the part of TRP and their associates.
